CULTURAL & SEASONAL NOTES

- The celebration is tied to Epiphany (January 6), which remembers the visit of the Three Wise Men to baby Jesus.
- Spanish traditions traveled to Latin America during the colonial period and became deeply rooted in countries like Mexico, Puerto Rico, the Dominican Republic, Cuba, and Central America.
- Over time, each country added its own customs (like Rosca de Reyes, shoes left out, grass for camels), but the core story stayed the same.
